



## Northeast Harbor, Maine September 20 - 23, 2019 4 Days, 5 meals

Near Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park we travel to Mount Desert Island which has been the ultimate vacation destination since before Columbus discovered the New

World. You will enjoy our stay at the quaint Kimball Terrace Inn overlooking the Northeast Harbor Yacht Marina and Mountains of Acadia. Included on this tour will be a guided tour of Acadia National Park, a visit to the Abbe Museum to learn about the area's rich history, a boat tour and much more.

Day 1, Friday 9/20 - We will make 2 rest stops along the way for breaks and lunch on own. We arrive at our hotel, Kimball Terrace Inn at approximately 4 pm and check in. Dinner is included this evening at the Tan Turtle Tavern located on the Inn's property. Dinner this evening offers a choice of Chicken Marsala, Fish & Shrimp Platter or Rib Eye Steak and is served with tossed salad, rolls, potato & vegetable, dessert & coffee. Please make a meal selection when making a reservation.

Day 2, Saturday 9/21 - Following breakfast we will head to the town of Bar Harbor for some shopping time. Town maps will be supplied. Lunch today is on your own and at 1:30 pm we will meet our step-on-guide for a 3-hour Acadia National Park Tour. Today we will explore the area, from stunning terrain and diverse wildlife to the beauty of Acadia National Park!



This fully-narrated tour offers the most complete and comprehensive sightseeing experience of the Downeast area. Following this tour You will have time for dinner on your own in downtown Bar Harbor and then we're off on a walking tour led by the mysterious "Lady in the Red Cloak". You will learn the early history of Bar Harbor and some old superstitions. We'll take a trip by the Village Burying Ground and walk to the most haunted mansion in town. This 90 minute walk is at a leisurely pace and there will be opportunity for questions during the tour. Following the tour we will return to the hotel for a good nights sleep. Turn over to continue.

Day 3, Sunday 9/22 - Again we begin the day with breakfast served at the Inn, and then board the Sea Princes for a morning cruise. This popular cruise of the Great Harbor of Mount Desert and Somes Sound Fjord is provided by Acadia National Park's Naturalist Program. You will get superb



views of Bear Island Lighthouse, nesting osprey and basking harbor seals framed by Acadia's dramatic mountains. A major highlight is a stop at the 200 year old lobster fishing village of Little Cranberry Island to visit Acadia National Park's renowned Islesford Historical Museum and to explore an unspoiled offshore island community reminiscent of days gone by. The last hour of the trip cruises deep into Somes Sound Fjord for a spectacular view of the vertical Eagle Cliffs rising directly from the sea. Following this morning cruise you will have time for lunch on own and then we're off to the Abbe Museum. In this first and only Smithsonian affiliated museum in the state of Maine, you will find dynamic and stimulating exhibitions and activities interspersed with spaces for quiet reflection. The history and cultures of the Native people in Maine, the Wabanaki, are showcased through changing



exhibitions. You will take a step back in time to early 20th century presentations of Native American archaeology in Maine. For dinner this evening you will experience a real Maine lobster bake that includes Native Mussels (lots of them) a 1 1/4 lb. steamed lobster, Corn on the Cob, Potato, Cole Slaw, Bread, Homemade Blueberry Cake, Coffee, Tea, Ice Tea. (For those who do not wish to have Lobster, a grilled Steak or Baked Haddock will be offered as a substitute.)

Day 4, Monday 9/23 - Following breakfast and checkout we depart at 9:30 am and will make our first stop at the famous Freeport Village Station. Home to the famous LL Bean outlet store this village is packed with several outlets and eateries. There will be time for lunch and shopping with an additional stop made for dinner on the way home.
