

Day 1 - Our first stop when arriving will be the Arlington National Cemetery. Included is a tram ticket which takes you for a tour through the cemetery with stops at the Kennedy Grave Site, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Arlington House. Then we travel to our home-base for 3 nights, the luxurious Embassy Suites in Old Town Alexandria. This 4-star hotel is an all-suite hotel and is just steps from historic King Street. This ideal location is perfect to enjoy waterfront dining, boutique shopping, and 18th- and 19th-century architecture.

Day 2 - After a hearty buffet breakfast at the hotel we are off to the National Mall for a visit to the Smithsonian Museums of your choice. We will begin and end at the Smithsonian Castle and the day is free to visit the many museums, art galleries and gardens.

Day 3 - Today we're off to visit George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate and Gardens. Included in your visit will be a guided overview tour. This tour is a broad overview of General Washington's accomplishments, character, and vision through the estate he created at Mount Vernon. It culminates in a private wreath laying at General Washington's Tomb. After lunch we will experience George Washington's Mount Vernon from a different perspective during a narrated sightseeing excursion on the Potomac River. As you travel north on the Potomac, hear stories of the people and animals who have inhabited its shores throughout history, including Native Americans, fish, and bald eagles. Pass by the imposing Fort Washington in Maryland and learn about the river's role in the Civil War. Tonight you will have a free evening to visit the MGM National Harbor Casino, or explore Old Town Alexandria.

Day 4 - This morning we'll head over to the National Zoo. Smithsonian's National Zoo sits on 163 acres in the heart of Washington, D.C.'s Rock Creek Park. Founded in 1889, the Zoo is currently home to more than 1,500 animals across 300 different species. Following our visit here we will journey home with rest stops and a dinner stop in route.
