

Join us in Amish Country, Lancaster, PA for the Sight & Sound Theatre's brand new production of "Queen Esther". This show is a captivating tale of beauty and bravery. Experience one of the most riveting Bible stories of the Old Testament as it comes to life with magnificent sets, special effects and live animals in this brand-new, original stage production!

Day 1 - Upon arrival in PA we will have a fun visit to Wilbur Chocolate Store in beautiful Lititz, PA to learn more about the world of chocolate, the history of Wilbur and the confectionery industry, and sample a free chocolate Wilbur Bud. Next we're off to the Julius Sturgis Pretzel Bakery. This tour in the original pretzel bakery, you'll get a hands-on lesson in pretzel twisting using a playdough mixture, observe the bakers twisting old-fashioned soft pretzels by hand, and shop for delicious treats and souvenirs in the bakery store.

We will check into the Clarion Inn & Suites of Lancaster and freshen up for dinner at Plain & Fancy Farm where you will enjoy a feast served family style to our table. After dinner we will see "Queen Esther" at Sight & Sound Theatre.

Following Breakfast on Saturday we will step back in time with a visit to Landis Valley Village & Farm Museum, considered by many to be the "best-kept secret in Pennsylvania." Founded by brothers Henry and George Landis, it is the largest "living history" village in the country dedicated to the total preservation of early Pennsylvania German/Dutch life. This authentic crossroads village includes historic buildings with costumed guides interpretation with a vast collection of historic agricultural equipment, and ongoing farming based on 1700's and 1800's practices and traditions. A wonderful horse and buggy ride included!
